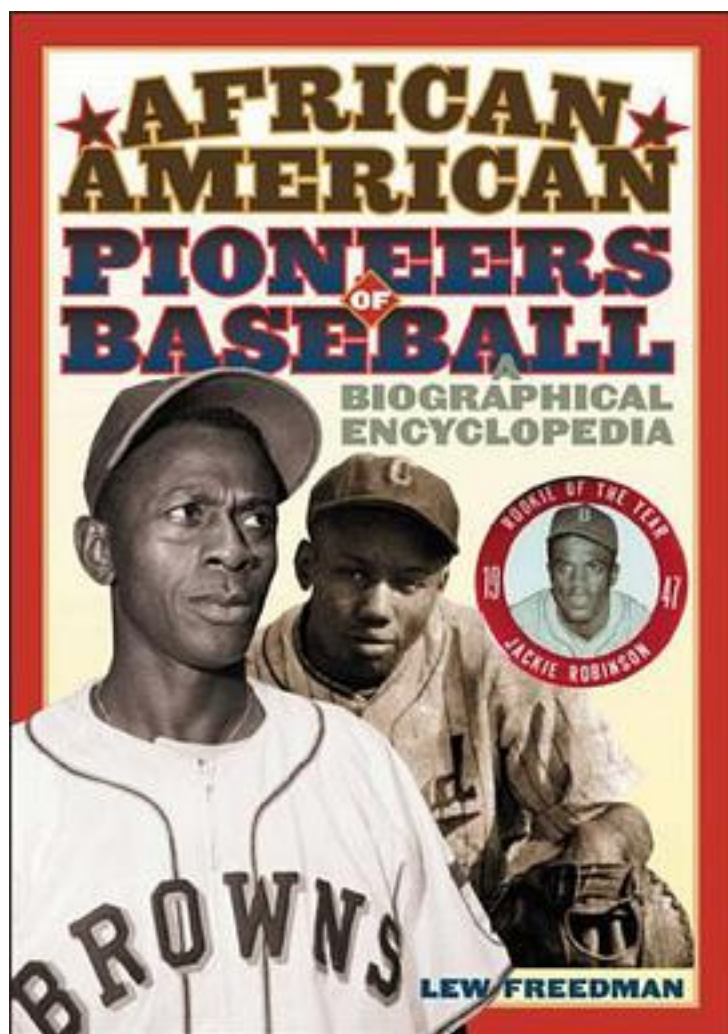


African American Pioneers of Baseball



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When Jackie Robinson became the first African American player in major league
