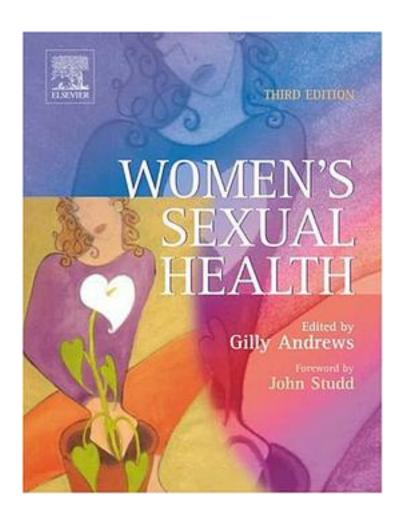
Women's Sexual Health
