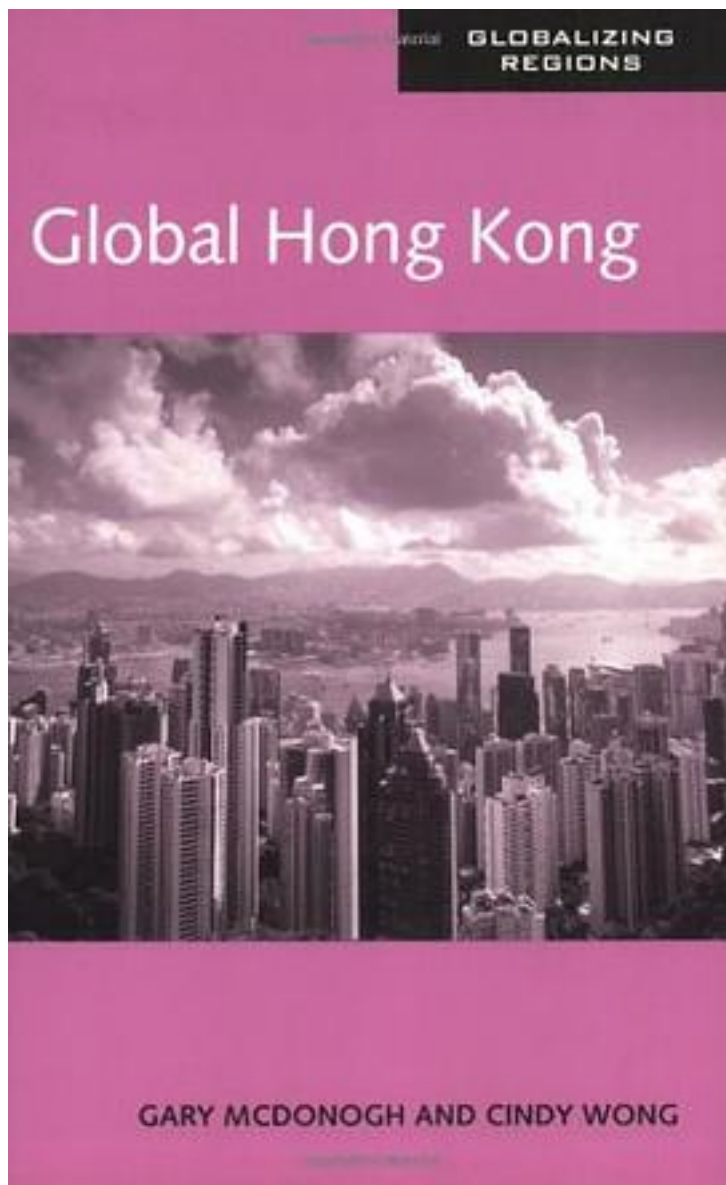

Providing a rich discussion of Hong Kong's history, society and it's enormously influential popular culture, this book will be essential reading for students of Hong Kong and Chinese studies courses, cultural studies, and also urban studies.
