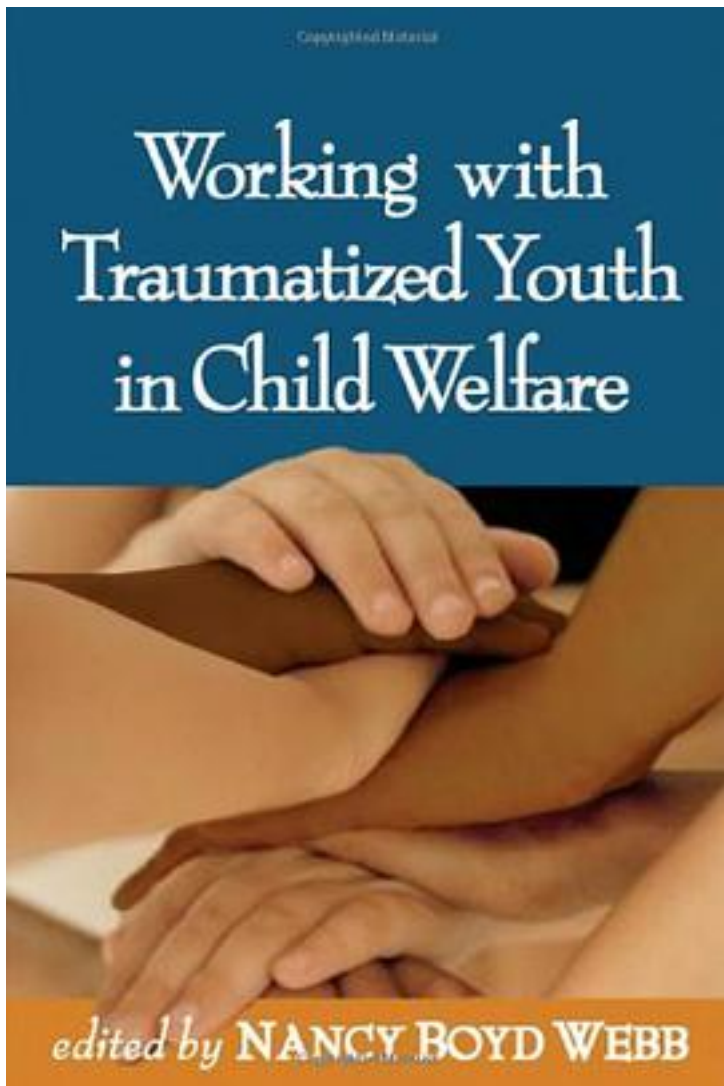


Working With Traumatized Youth in Child Welfare



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Until recently, there has not been a great deal of overlap in the child welfare and trauma literatures. This text promises to cross that divide by integrating perspectives from both fields, to help practitioners understand and address the special needs of maltreated children and adolescents, and their families. Current knowledge on attachment, trauma, and risk and resilience is clearly explained, including the impact of abuse on the brain. Readers learn how to conduct assessments and implement a range of effective helping strategies, with youth in foster care and other settings.
