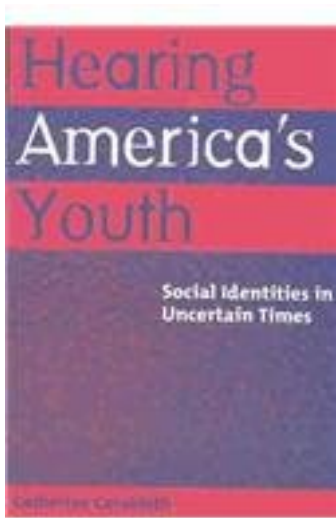

How young people see themselves affects the way they think about and act on and in their lives and worlds, and thus shapes our collective futures.
