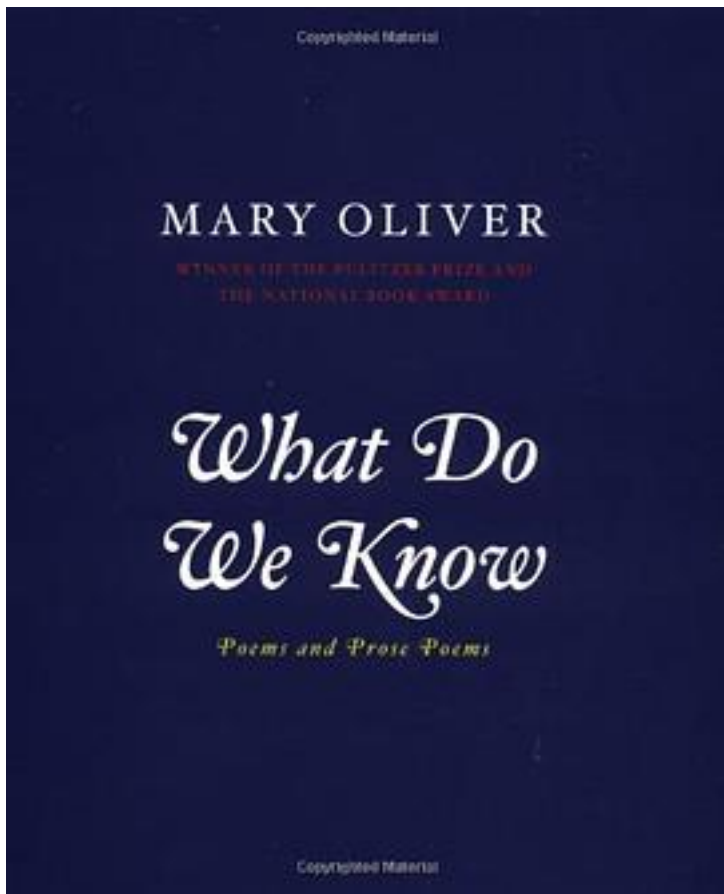


What Do We Know
