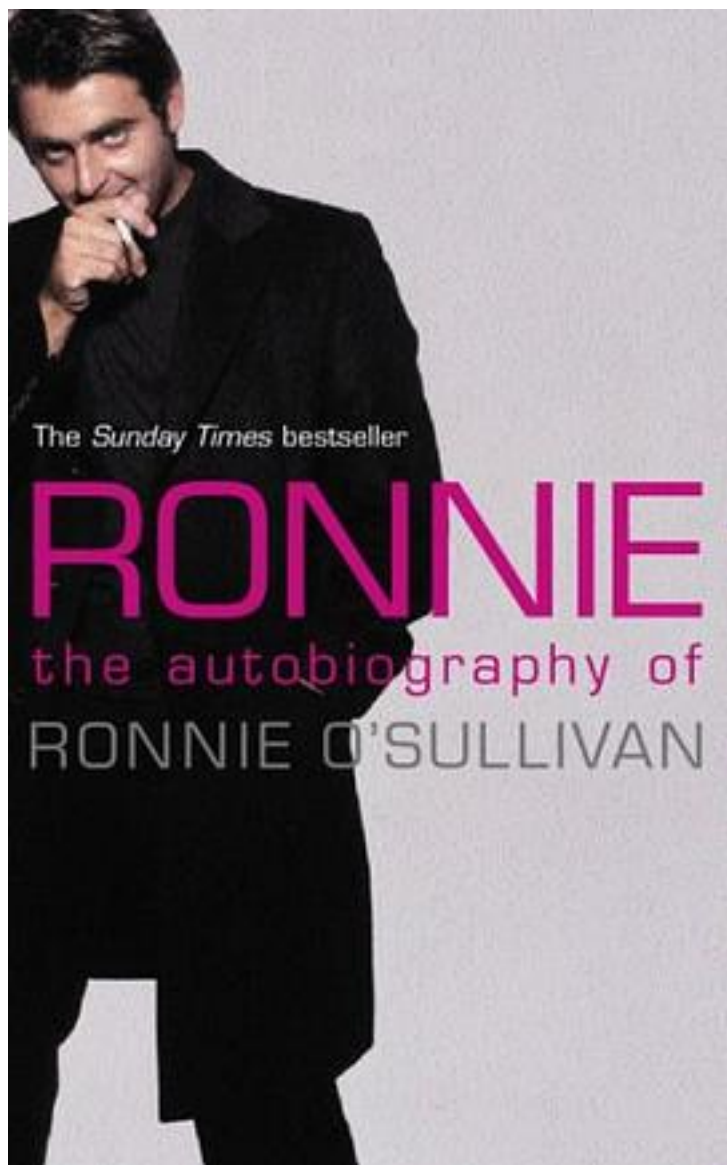


Ronnie
