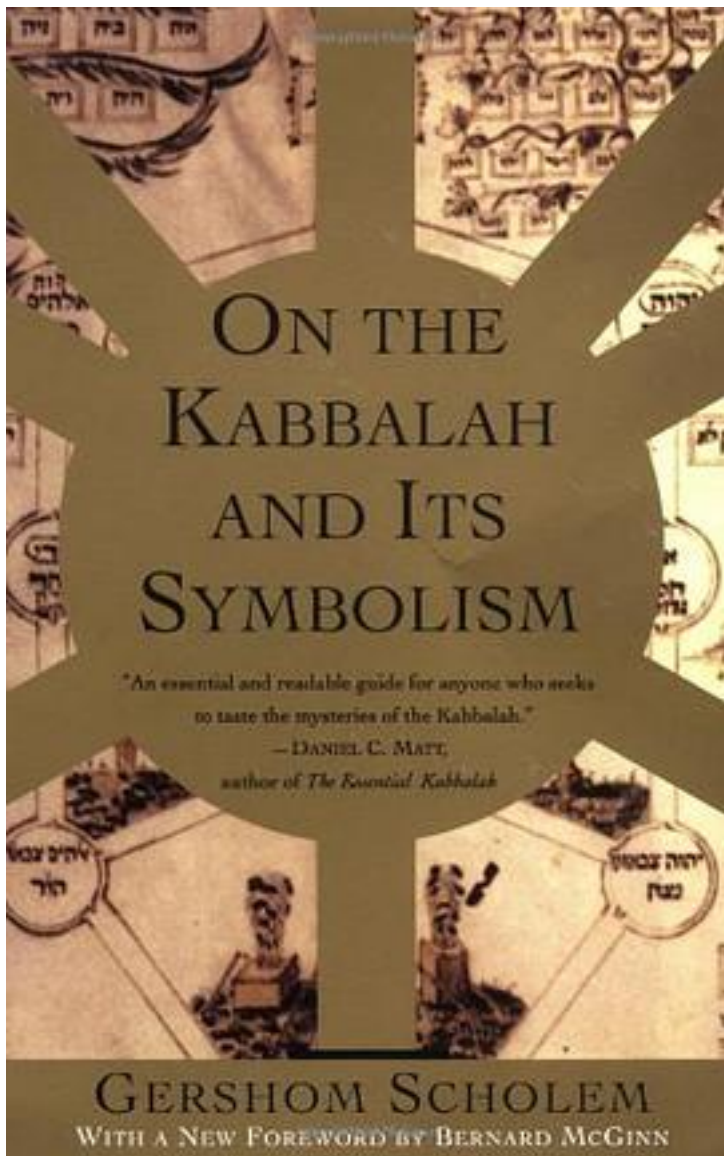


On the Kabbalah and its Symbolism
