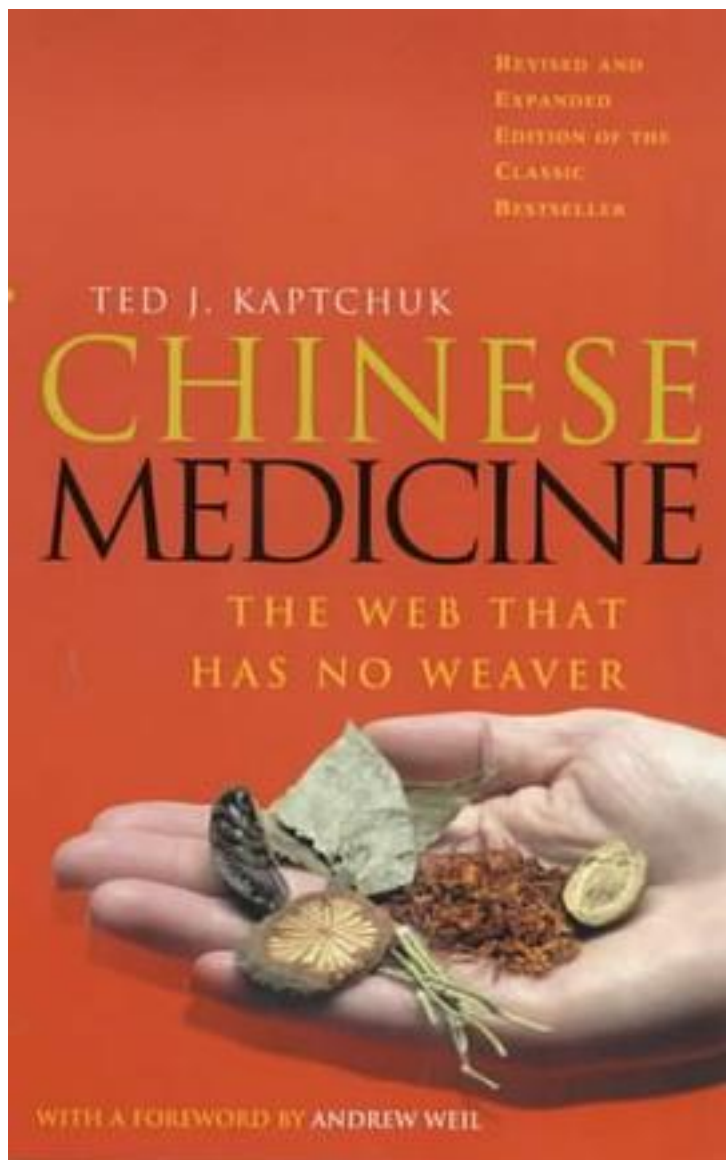


Chinese Medicine
