

Throughout the story, Margaret continues to compete with her brother. She wants a sports model wheelchair, while her father insists that she needs a waterbed. Rabe has a definite theme, that handicapped children can lead active and productive lives. Margaret and her friend sell lemonade and sing in the park, and Margaret gets a job stacking groceries in a store. Margaret is a believable little girl and her relationships with her family are nicely done, showing that life has similar ups and downs for the handicapped, but the ending is a bit contrived and sugar-coated.
