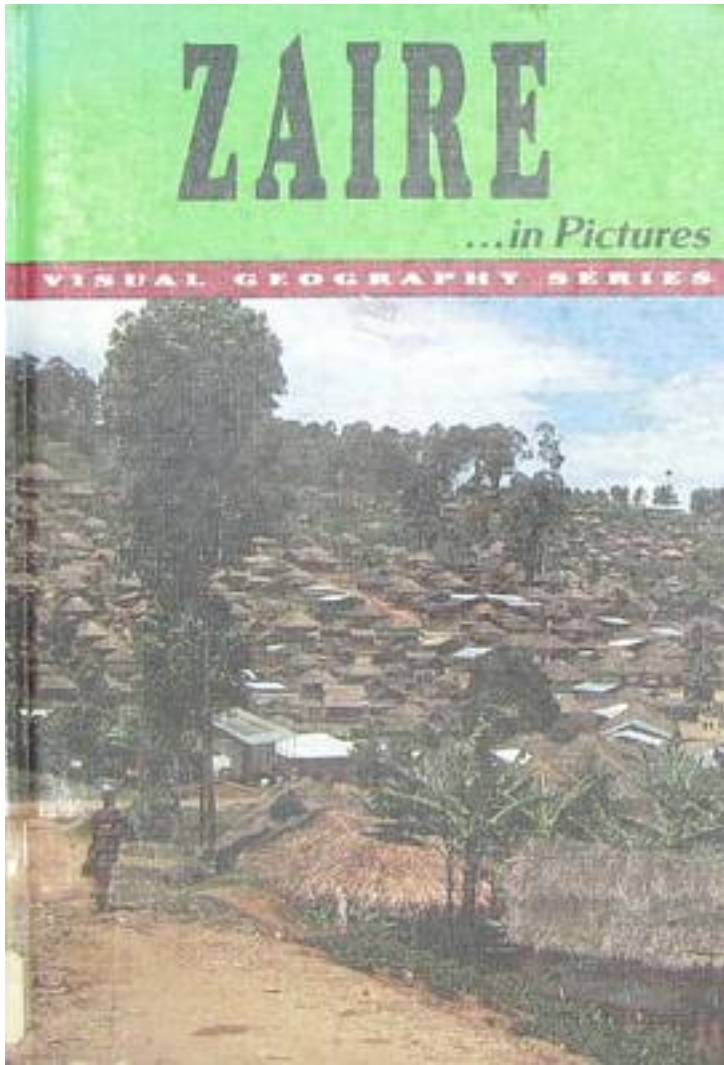

Zaire is the second largest country in Africa. From the fifteenth to the late nineteenth century, many thriving kingdoms evolved. The nation has 37.8 million citizens and more in Zaire. Most of the people in these kingdoms lived in small villages and relied on hunting, farming, and fishing for survival. More than 200 ethnic groups exist, most of which speak a Bantu language. Bantu language makes up over 10 percent of the total population. In the sixteenth century, slave trading with Europeans became an important economic activity for some local leaders. Although they live in a country that has great mineral wealth, most Zaireans do not have enough money to feed, clothe, and educate their families. In fact, if measured by average income per person, Zaire is one of the world's poorest nations. Zaire's vast store of minerals attracted Belgium's King Leopold II. He signed treaties with hundreds of African leaders to mine and sell Zaire's
