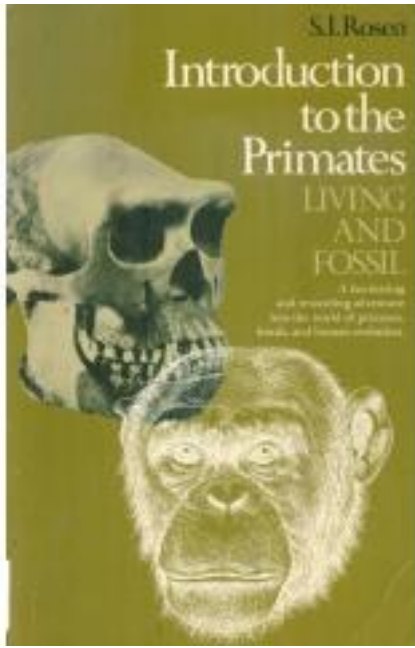

This book is written particularly for the beginning student who is being exposed for the first time to the Primates as a field of academic study. This student may be in an anthropology, primatology, zoology, psychology, or natural science course, since the study of the primates knows no boundaries. The genetics student may also find this book of interest in light of the great variety of primates, living and fossil. Whatever the

case may be, the student is faced with a mass of different types of primates and all even greater mass of what will appear miscellaneous information. This introductory text is designed to simplify this situation, for it should be the goal of every beginning text to simplify the complex. First, the Primates are divided into two logical groupings: the modern, or living primates; and the fossil ones, the primates of the past. A second way of simplifying matters is the use of the pattern concept: no single primate or group of primates is defined on a basis of one or two characteristics but on the general pattern displayed. By use of boldface type, the student is presented not only with what is important and what to remember but also has a quick reference system for reviewing. Each chapter has a pattern summary at the end so the reader can check his recall and quickly refer back to the corresponding boldface print.
