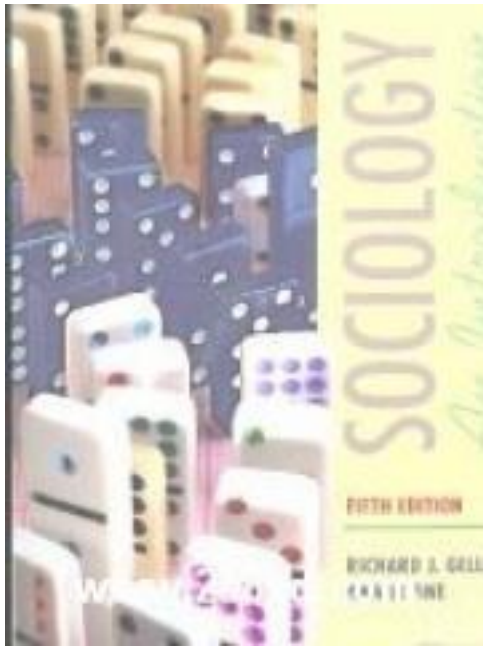


Sociology: An Introduction



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We begin this book by inviting you to look at the World around you through the eyes of a sociologist. The sociological perspective is unique both because of the kinds of knowledge sociologists seek (described in Chapter 1) and because of the ways they go about acquiring that knowledge (the subject of Chapter 2). Chapter 1 compares the images of social reality that we get from television news and our own commonsense understanding of events with the insights you will gain through sociology. Emile Durkheim's classic study of suicide illustrates what is unique about the sociological perspective. The mass media often report what sociologists or other scientists have learned about family violence for example but rarely tell you how they arrived at these conclusions. Chapter 2 goes "behind the scenes" to show how sociol-
