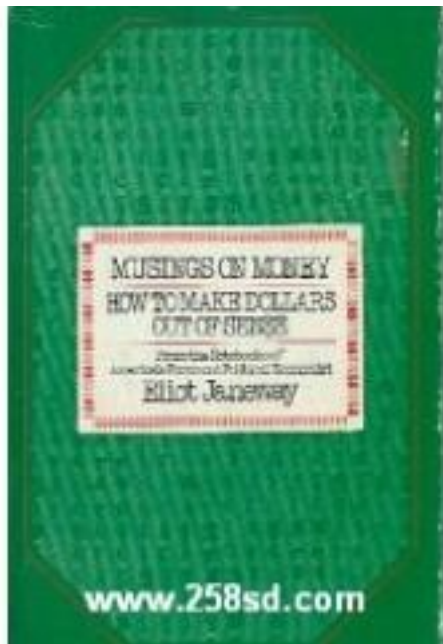

make sensible decisions when managing those dollars.
 Everybody has opinions about what m do with
money-but a little knowledgc is a dangerous thing. The
\"financial advisers\" advertising their wares in all the
media are selling invesnment technology in the form of
