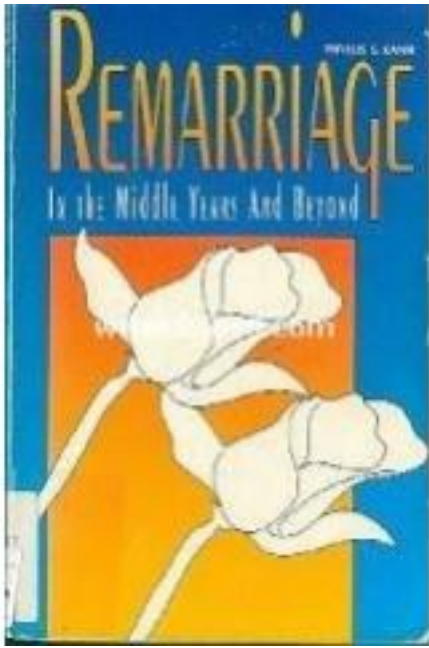

Historian-philosopher Bertrand Russell was merely reporting the history of human mating when he wrote: "Man is not a solitary animal."
