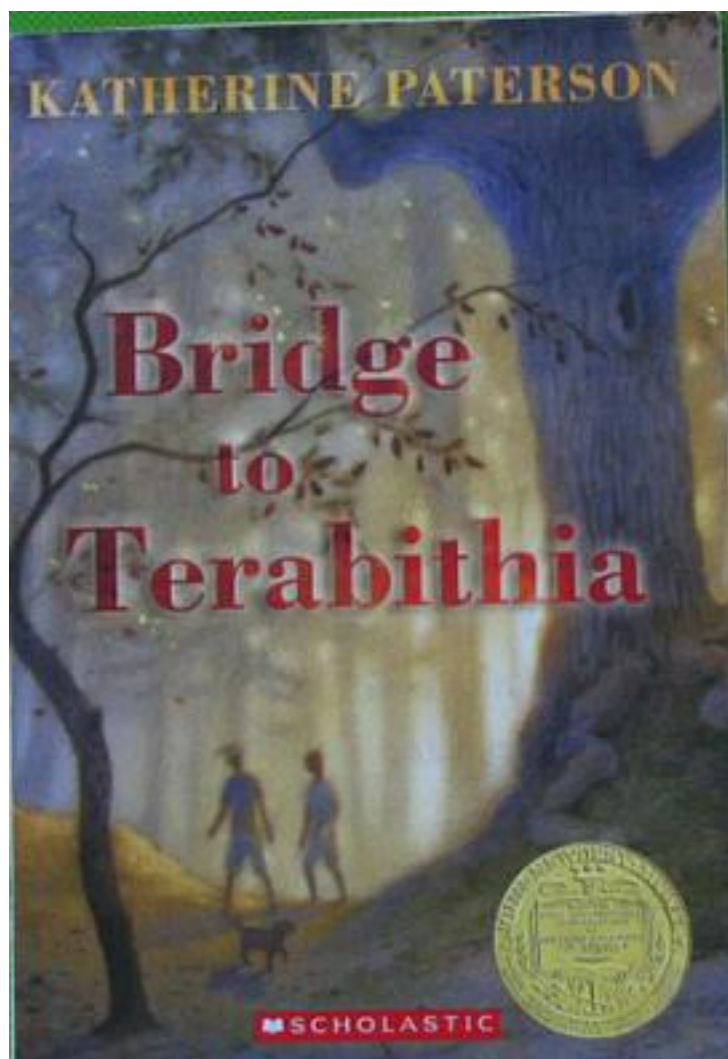

这本书断断续续看的。没想到生词还不少。文笔较一般儿童文学稍微复杂了一些。看进去的时候挺引人入胜的。结局有些伤感。不过Leslie的结局其实是可以避免的。到最后也不知道要感动什么。或许这是大人与小孩的不同吧。这个版本纸质不大好，不是很推荐。想了想，减去一颗星吧，总觉得达不到五星的感觉。

跟着学生读了很多儿童文学，这一本与众不同，语言漂亮，情节贴近学生的生活，而且从中能够感受到童年独有的快乐——创造秘境、并独享拥有它的快乐。谁的童年没有一个“秘密基地”呢？最后的结局有一些出乎意料，令人唏嘘的同时，也体会到作者的“别有用心”。对于孩童而言，死亡的意义是什么？失去自己最爱的人的感受是怎样的？他们从无知懵懂、自欺欺人到最后接受现实、感知生命、获得成长。这座桥的意义需要反复咀嚼啊……好书！此外，这一版的插图很生动、浪漫，和细腻的笔触相得益彰。
