

High school graduates must make choices -- many choices. And that's where this book fits in. It encourages the graduate to make his or her own choices, but with humor and sparkle points out that the wise graduate will accept the advice and help of others in plotting his or her future.

Joe McGloin wants to see young adults develop self-esteem, spiritual wholeness, moral values, and social awareness. He stimulates them to do so, sometimes prodding them with a witticism or a nifty cartoon. But always the challenge is there: "You are living right now -- unless of course you have chosen only to dream. You can't wait until you have grown completely and become an "adult." You live as you grow, and you either grow all your life or you wither and die."
