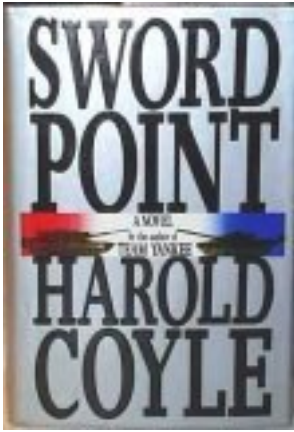

He takes us from the White House and the Kremlin to the battlefield, as the life of each character is changed--or brutally ended--by the rapidly escalating war, while the stakes are raised, with the Iranians reportedly on the verge of assembling a nuclear device
