Should space explorers report the existence of an abnormal colony to the central authorities or let it develop as it wants to, contrary to all rules? And what about the past? Does it have anything to say to the future? Can it help us deal with our problems now and tomorrow?

These are all problems for us now, and they are problems for the people, the very real people, in these stories. Each of these stories is new. And in each, the author is exploring a new area, a new idea, that he or she has not touched on before. The stories are not related to each other. But they are all a part of the huge pattern of human realities.
