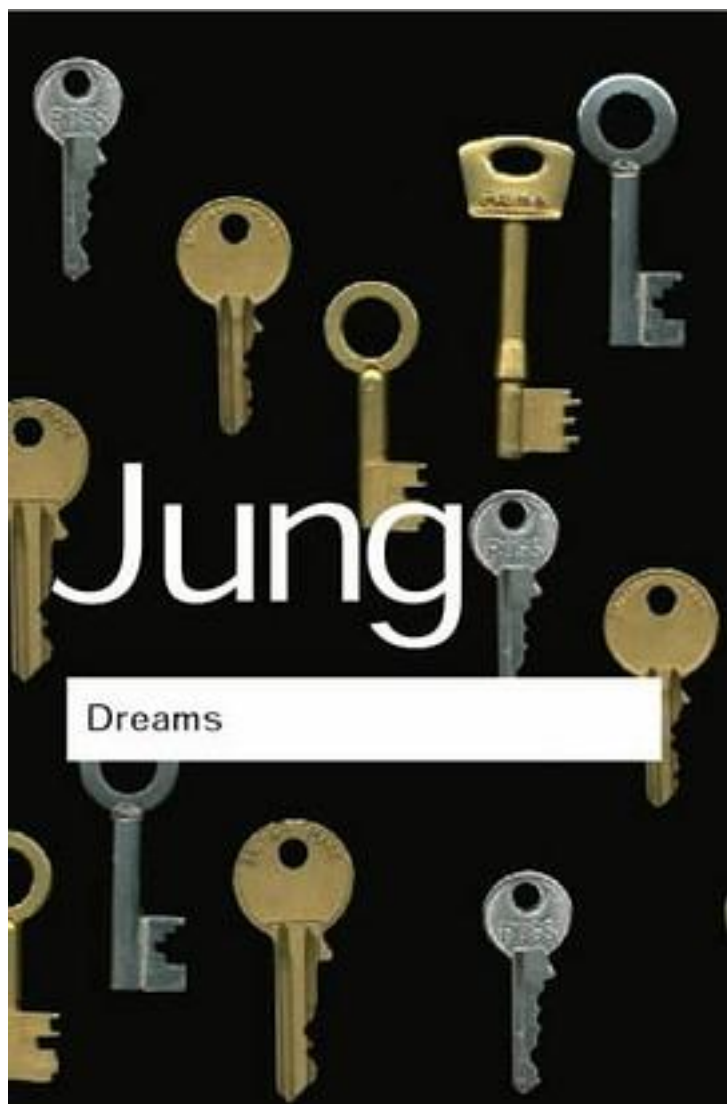


Dreams 梦
