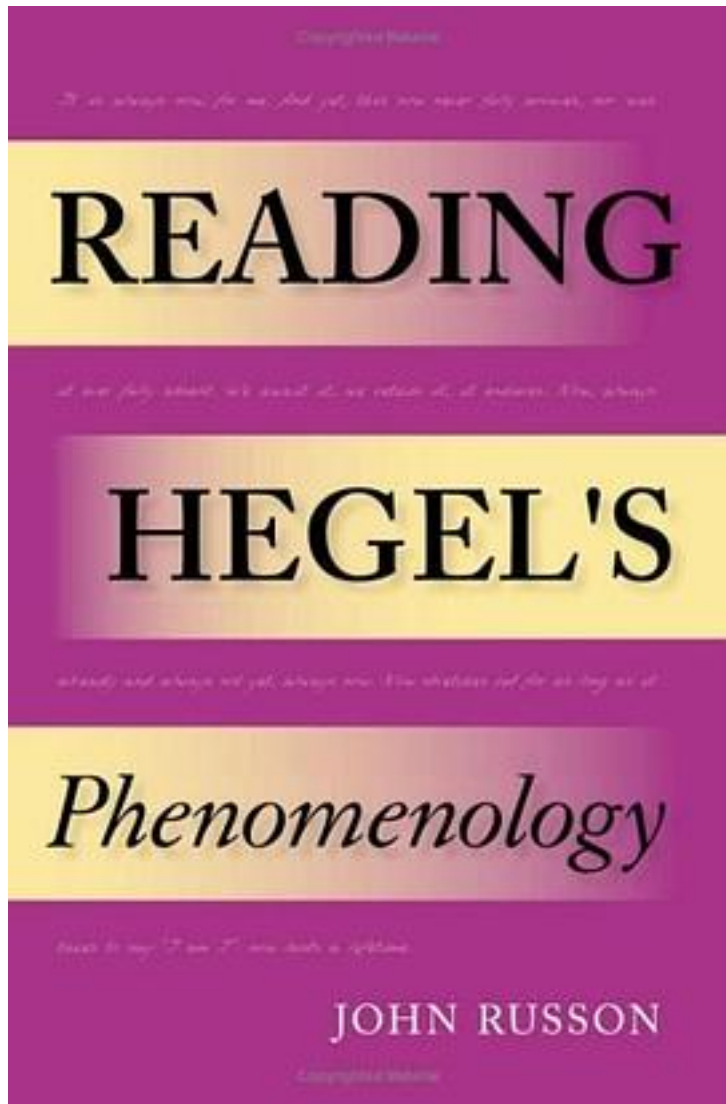

An important companion to contemporary Hegel studies, this book will be of interest to all students of Hegel's philosophy.
