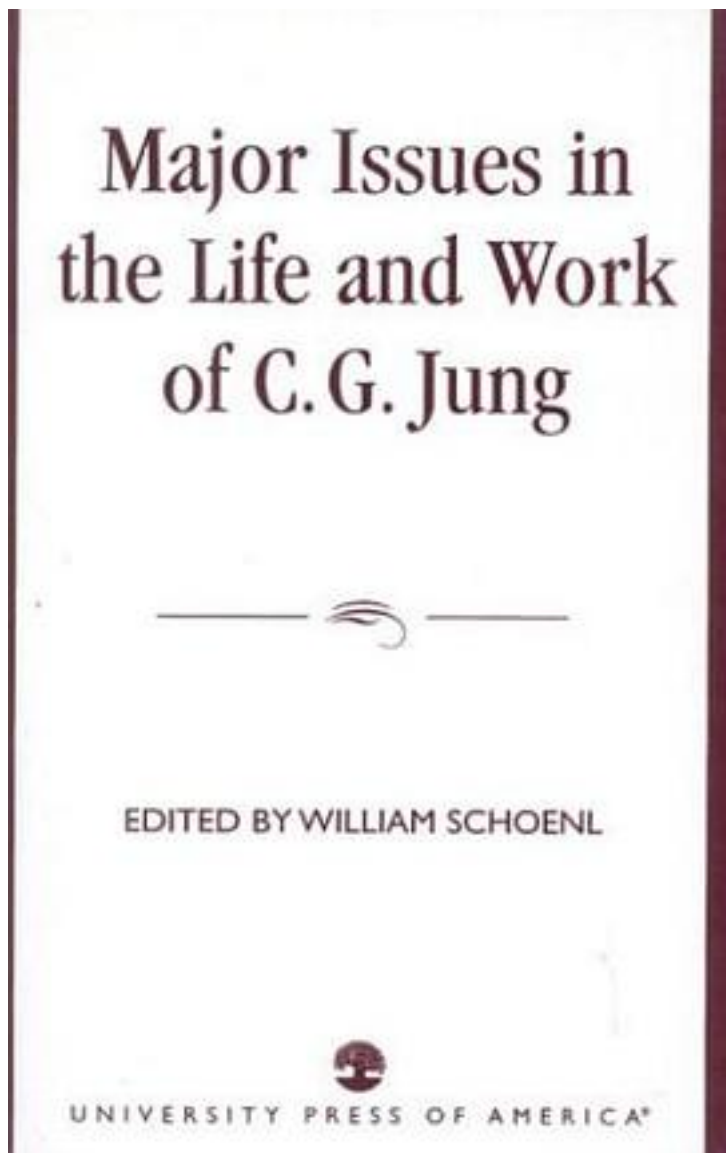


Major Issues in the Life and Work of C.G. Jung
