Philo Pierce; and a group of aged communists, heroic types, who live in bourgeois splendor. In high style, Maurccn Howard s virtuosity encompasses all of Mar-

garet's false moves--her trendy scripts and trendy novels--and asks some important questions. What is left to value in a world where our deepest feelings are grist for the mill, and what of political commitment in a country that so desperately wants to be entertained? For what price does Margaret Flood trade private life for the public name? With this extraordinary novel, Mauryeen Howard stakes out, more compellingly than ever before, her position in the front ranks of contemporary writers of fiction.
