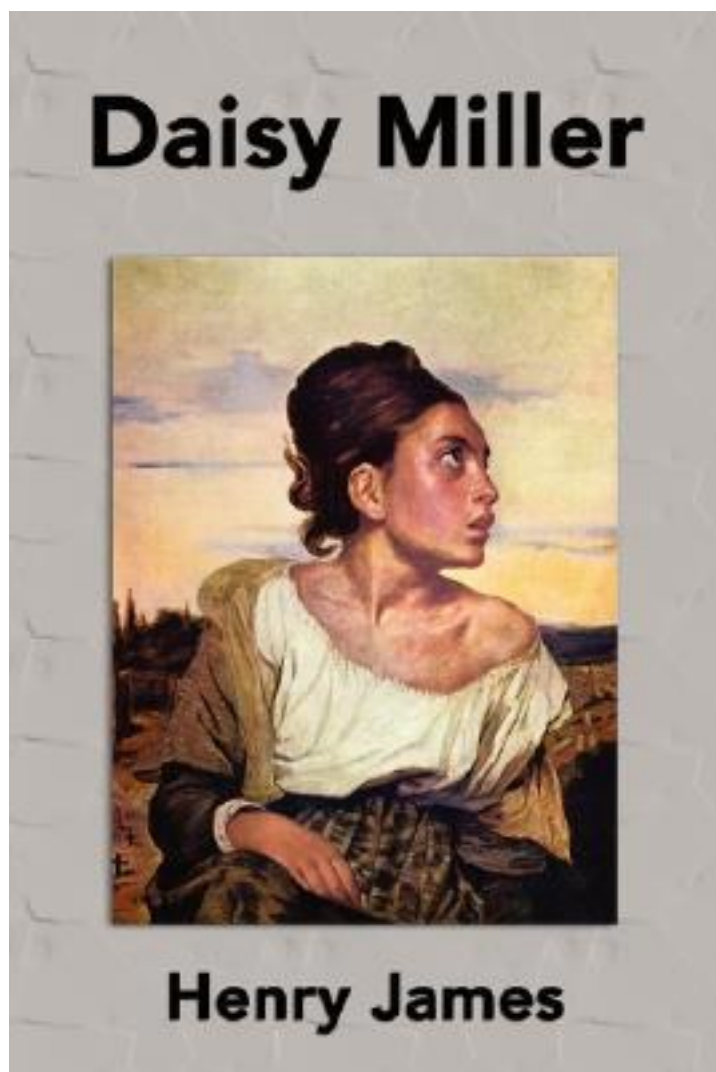


Daisy Miller
