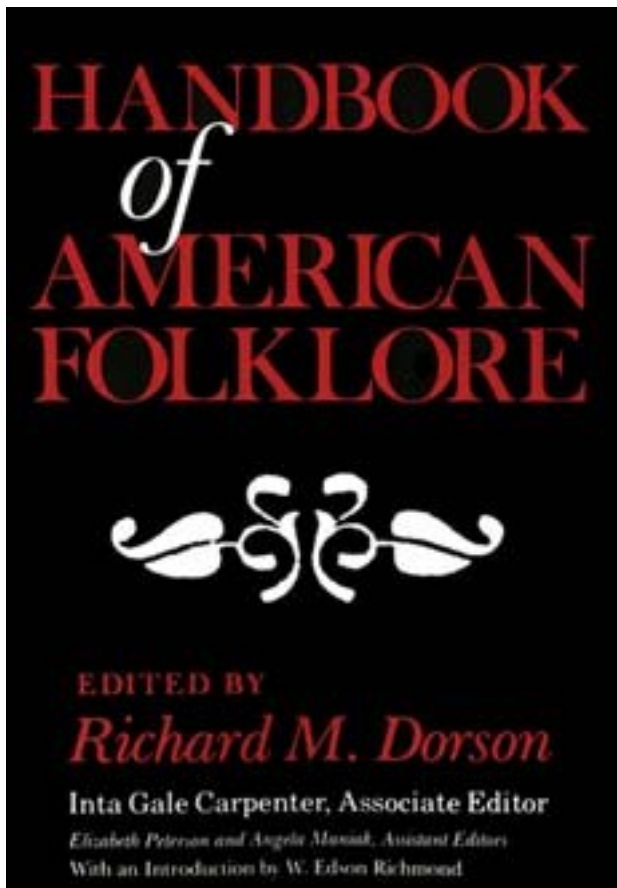


Handbook of American Folklore
