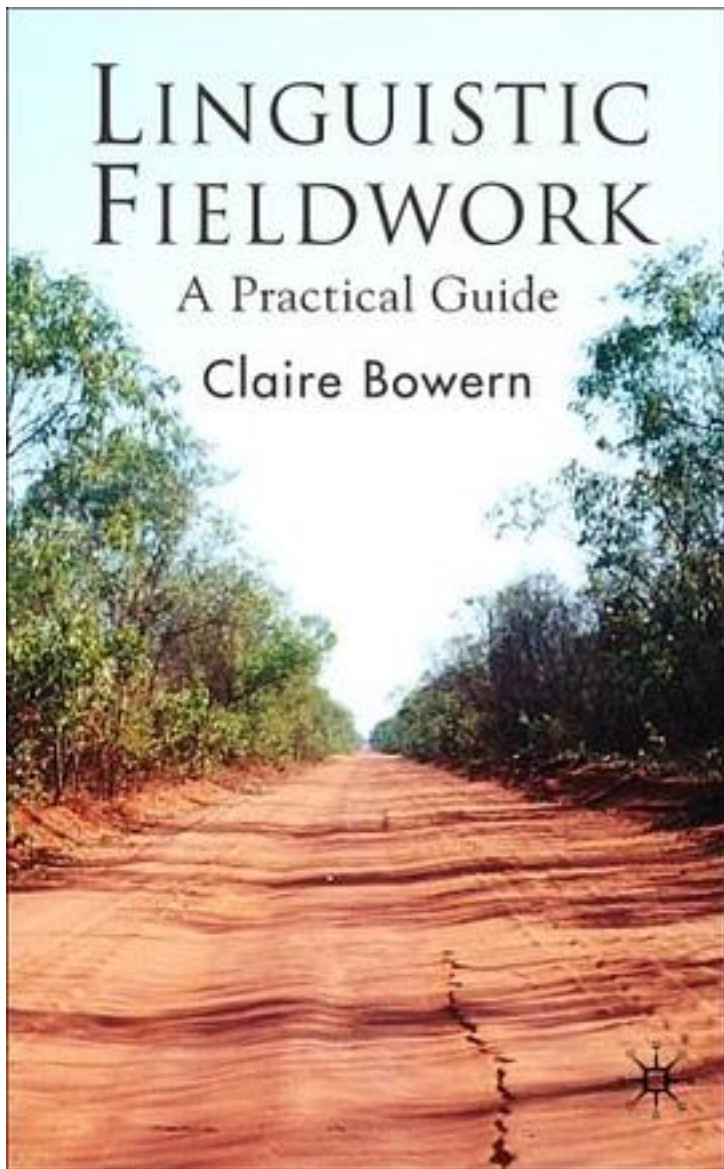


Linguistic Fieldwork

Doing field research isn't like working in the lab with chemicals: both the field worker and their consultants are real people who interact in complex ways.
