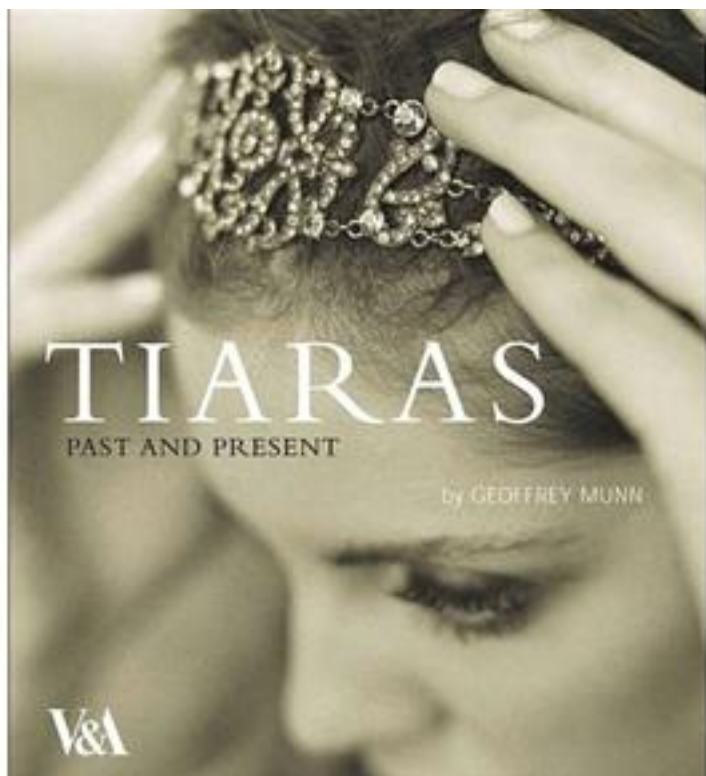


Tiaras
