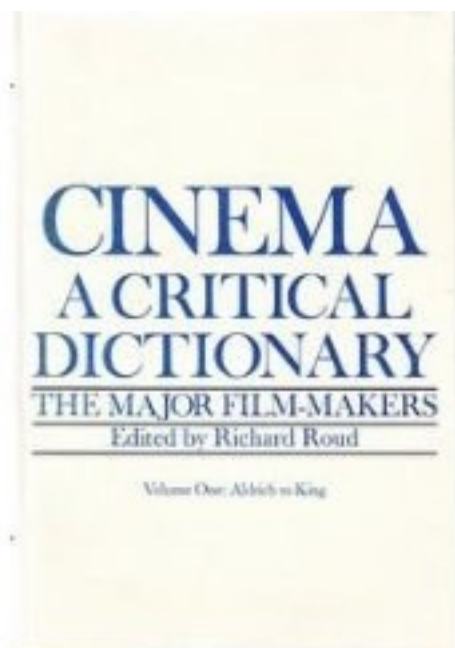


Cinema A Critical Dictionary
