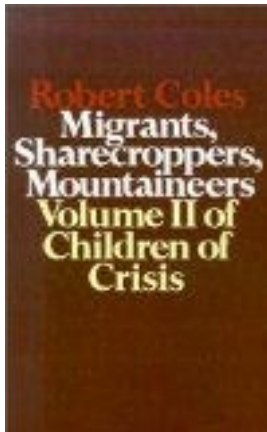

Since the late 1950's, Robert Coles has been studying, living with, and, above all, listening to the American poor.
