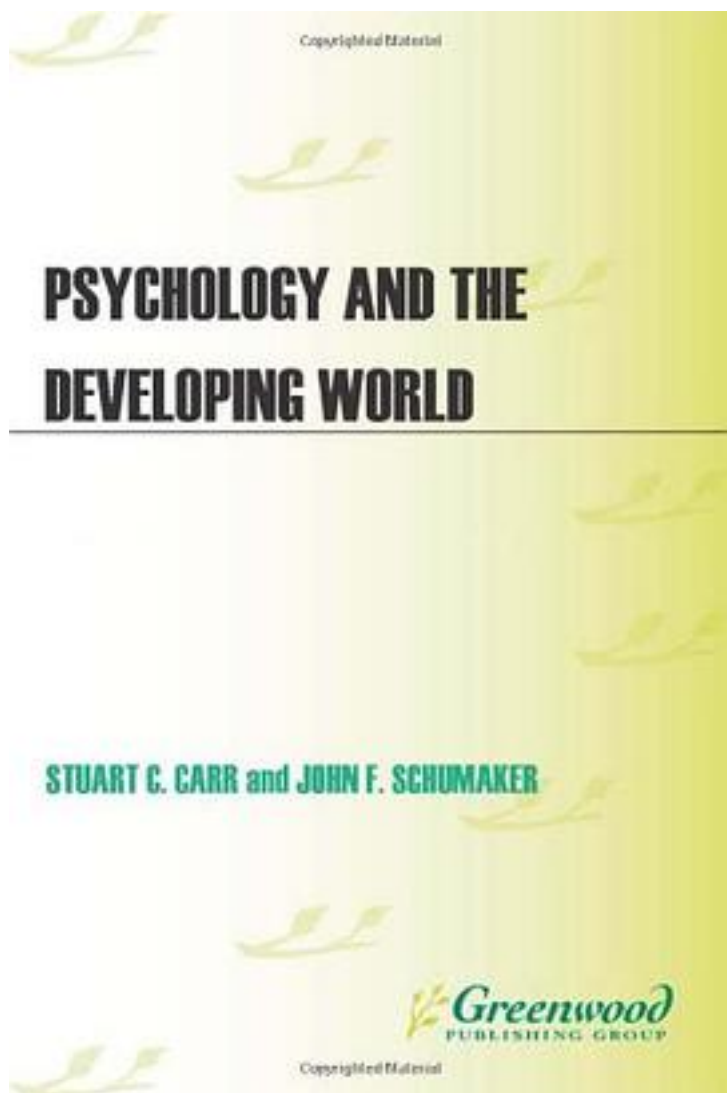


Psychology and the Developing World
