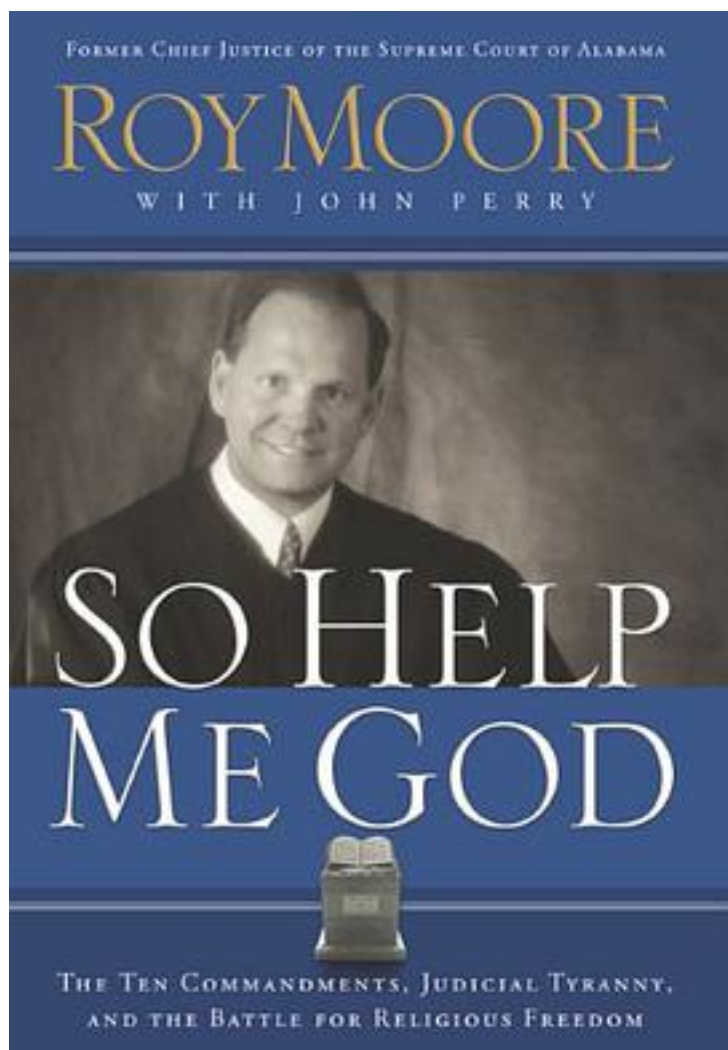

Today's dispute over the line between church and state (or the lack thereof) is neither the first nor the fiercest in our history.
