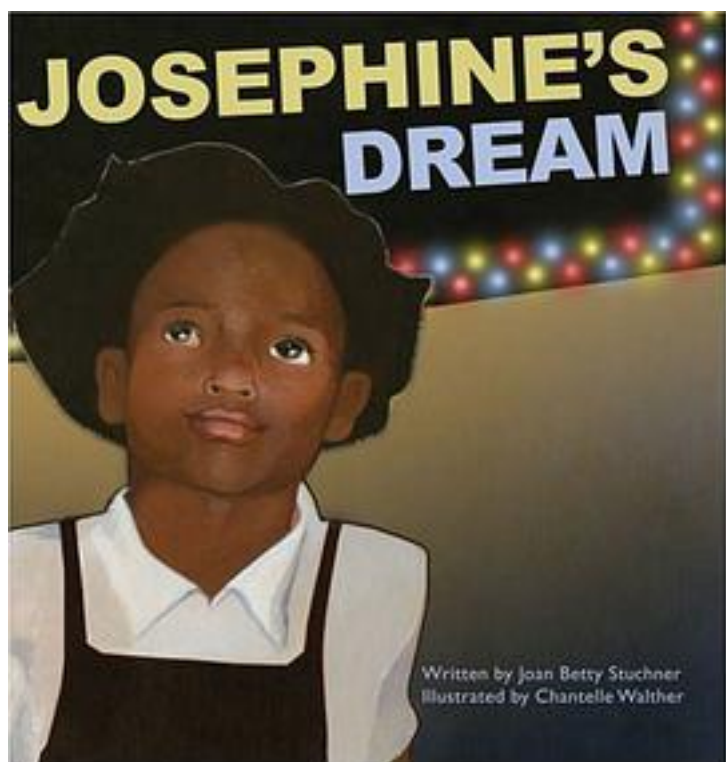

After her return to America, she joined Dr. Martin Luther King Jr., speaking at the March on Washington--the only woman to do so. With
