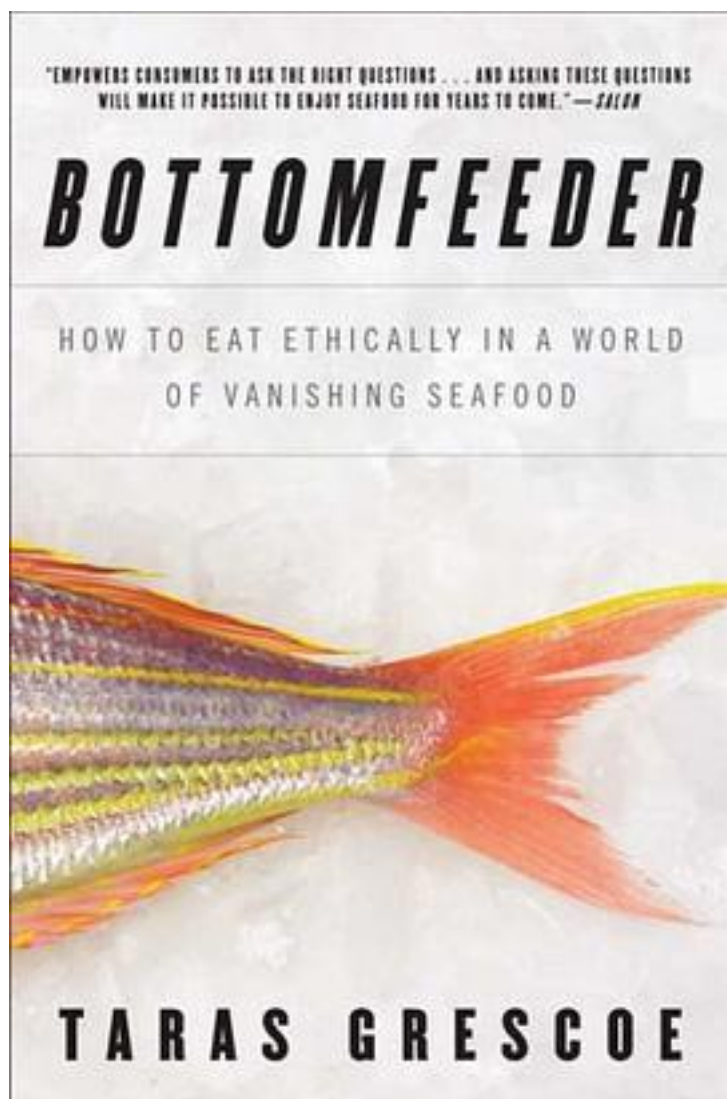


Bottomfeeder
