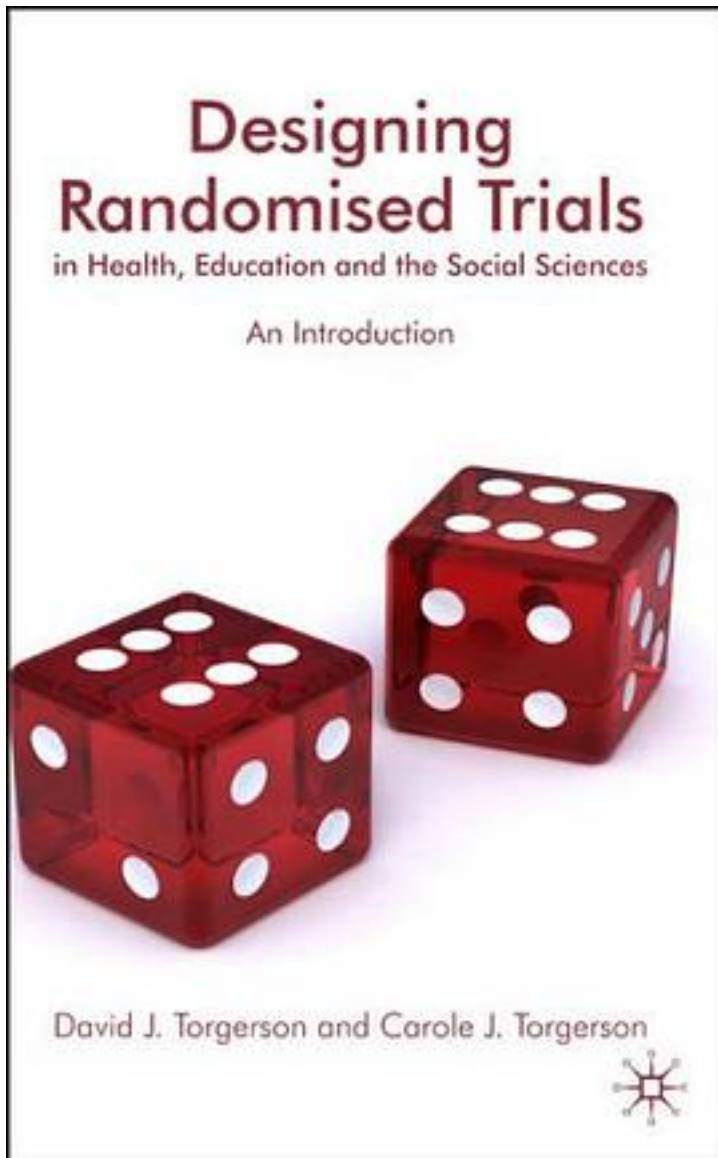

Evidence-based policy increasingly demands rigorous randomized trials.
