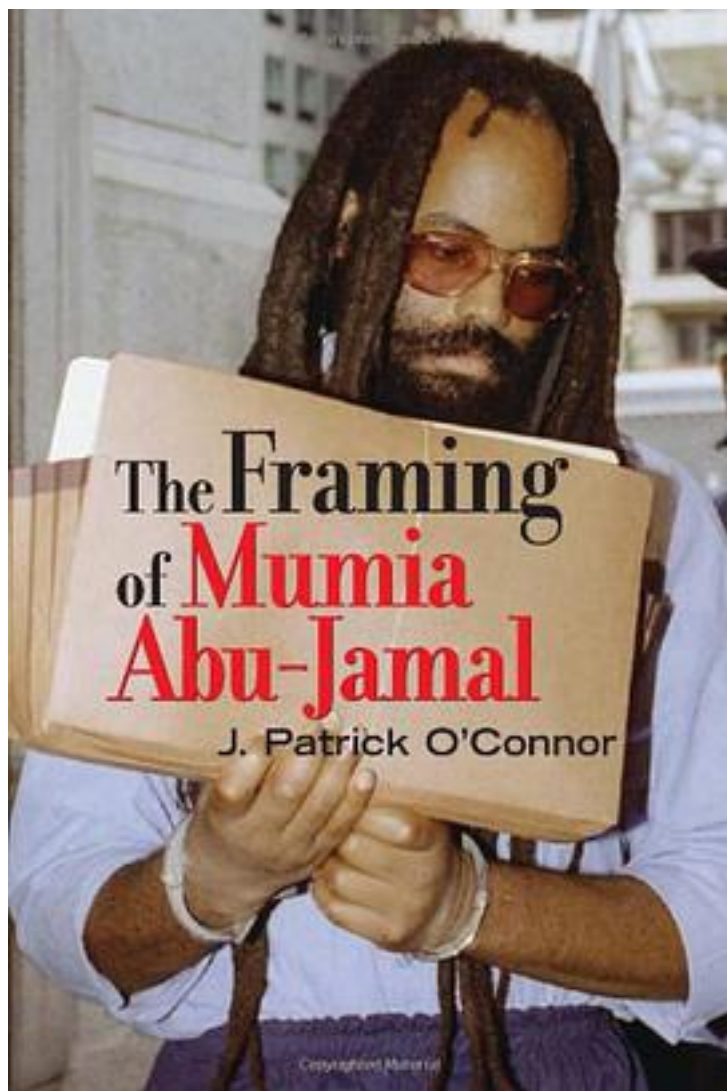


The Framing of Mumia Abu-Jamal
