

A former Wallace Stegner Fellow at Stanford University and a graduate of the Iowa Writers' Workshop, he has also received fellowships from the National Endowment for the Arts, the James Michener/Copernicus Society and the MacDowell Colony.

His short fiction has appeared in McSweeney's #9 and #11, Ploughshares, StoryQuarterly, The Atlantic Unbound, ZYZZYVA, Epoch, Five Points, and elsewhere.

His first full-length play, Monster in the Dark (a collaboration with foolsFURY Theater Company), was produced in San Francisco and Berkeley in early 2008.

He holds a B.A. from Stanford and a J.D. from UC-Berkeley, and he has taught at Stanford, California College of the Arts, and St. Edward's University in Austin, Texas, where he is currently an assistant professor of creative writing. A three-time Jeopardy! champion, he lives in Austin with his wife and a few critters.
