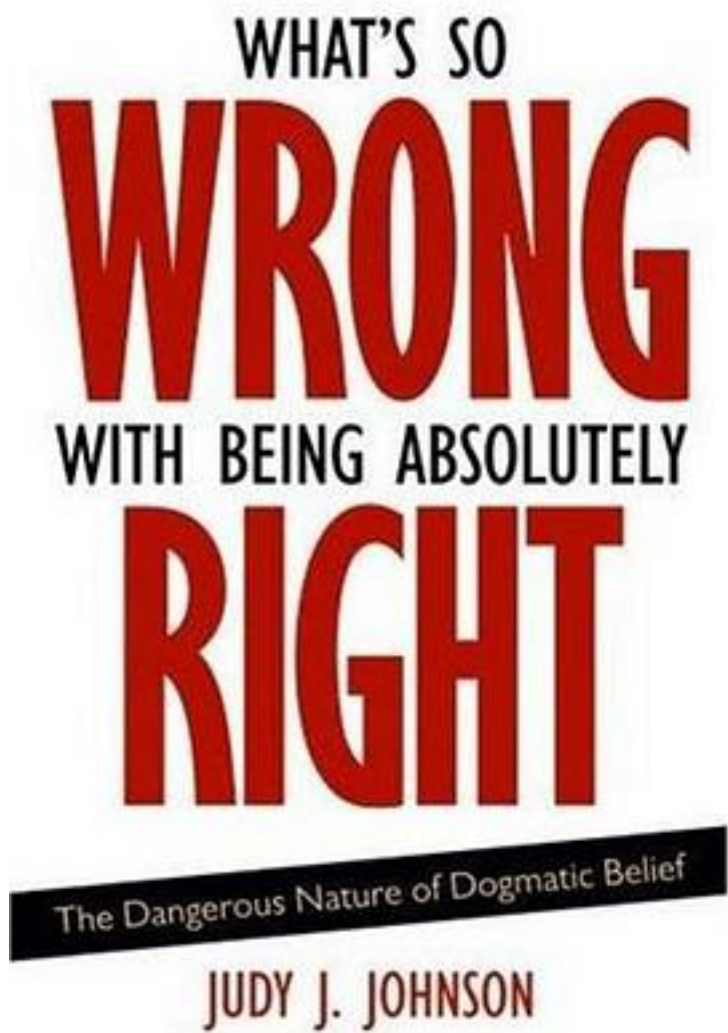


What's So Wrong with Being Absolutely Right
