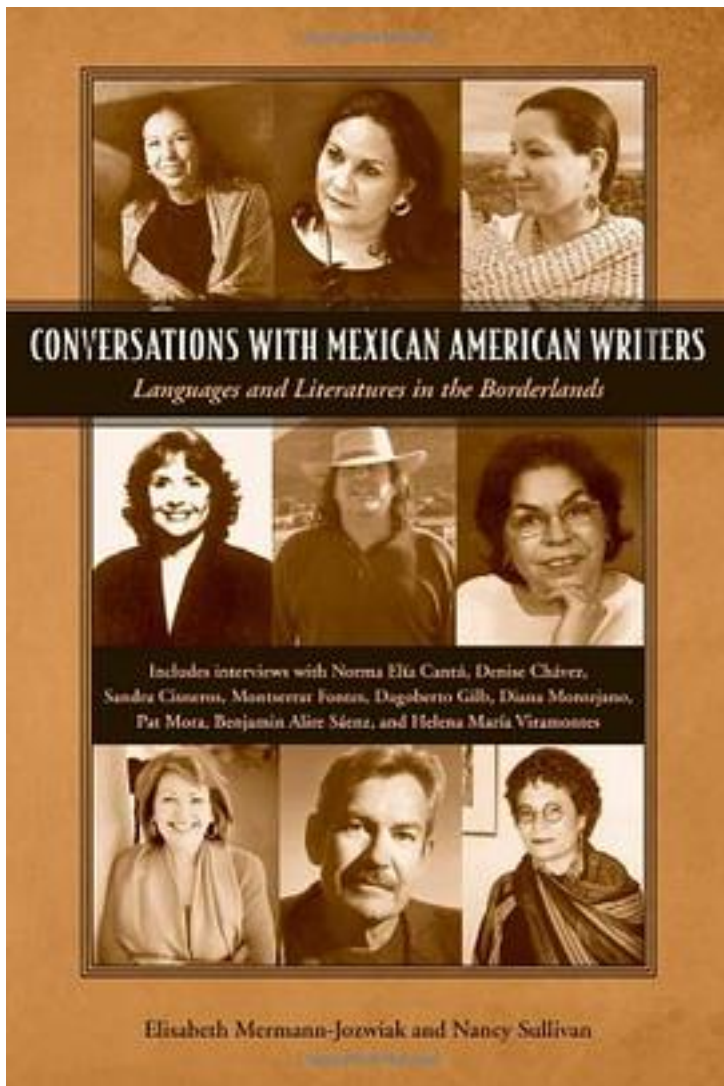

Through a series of interviews with nine acclaimed authors, "Conversations with Mexican American Writers" explores the languages and literature of the U.S.-Mexico borderlands as a confluence of social, cultural, historical, and political forces. Out of these interviews emerges a portrait of the borderlands as a dynamic space of international exchange, one that is situated and can only be understood fully within a global context.
