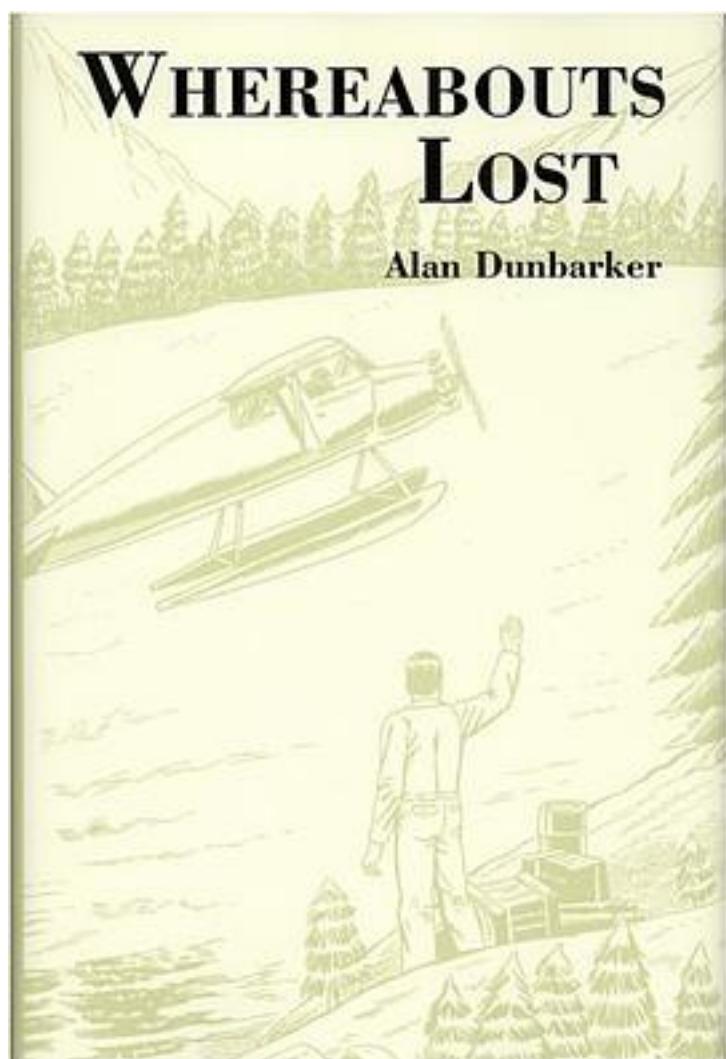


Whereabouts Lost
