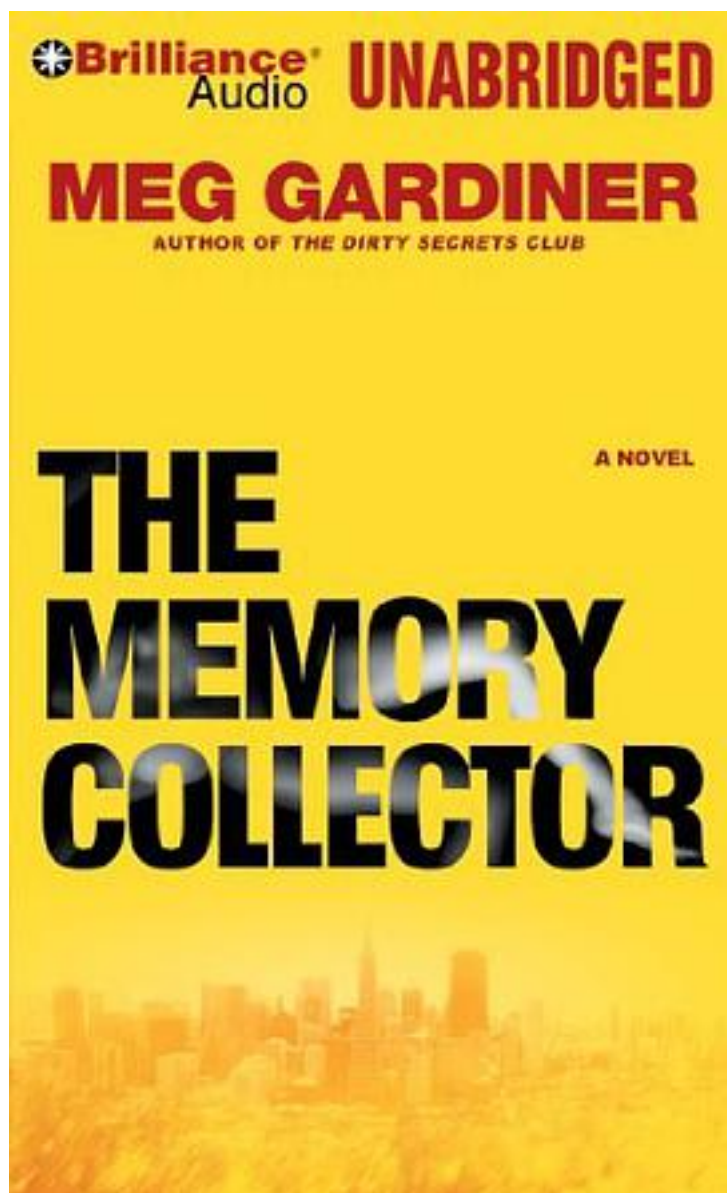


The Memory Collector
