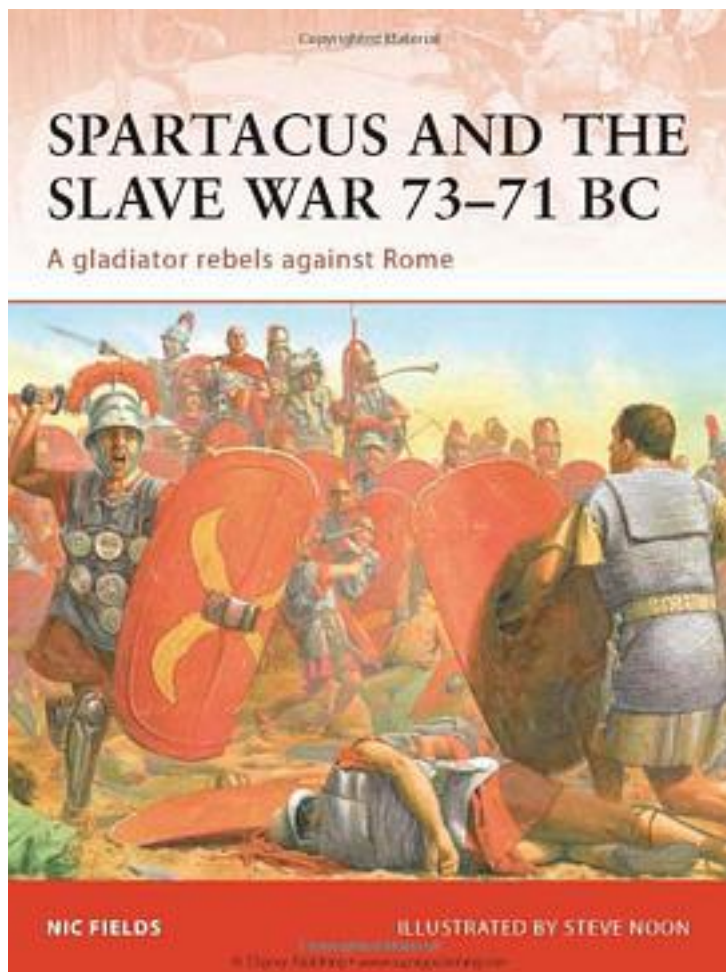

Crassus crucified 6,000 prisoners as an example to others who might think of revolt.
