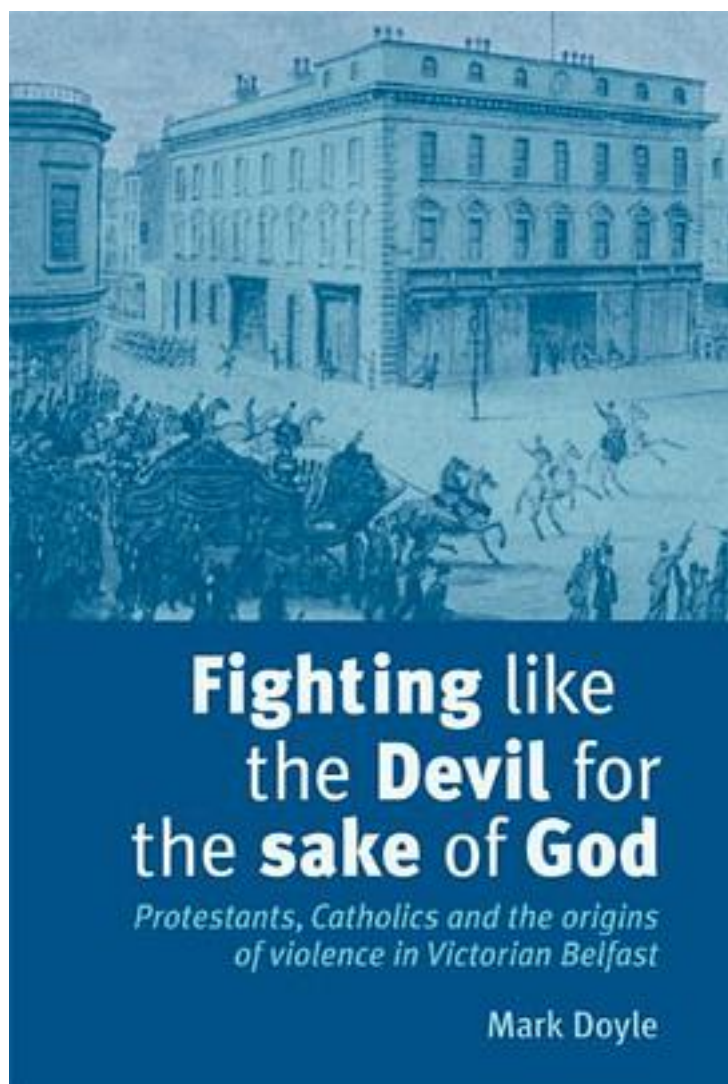


Fighting Like the Devil for the Sake of God
