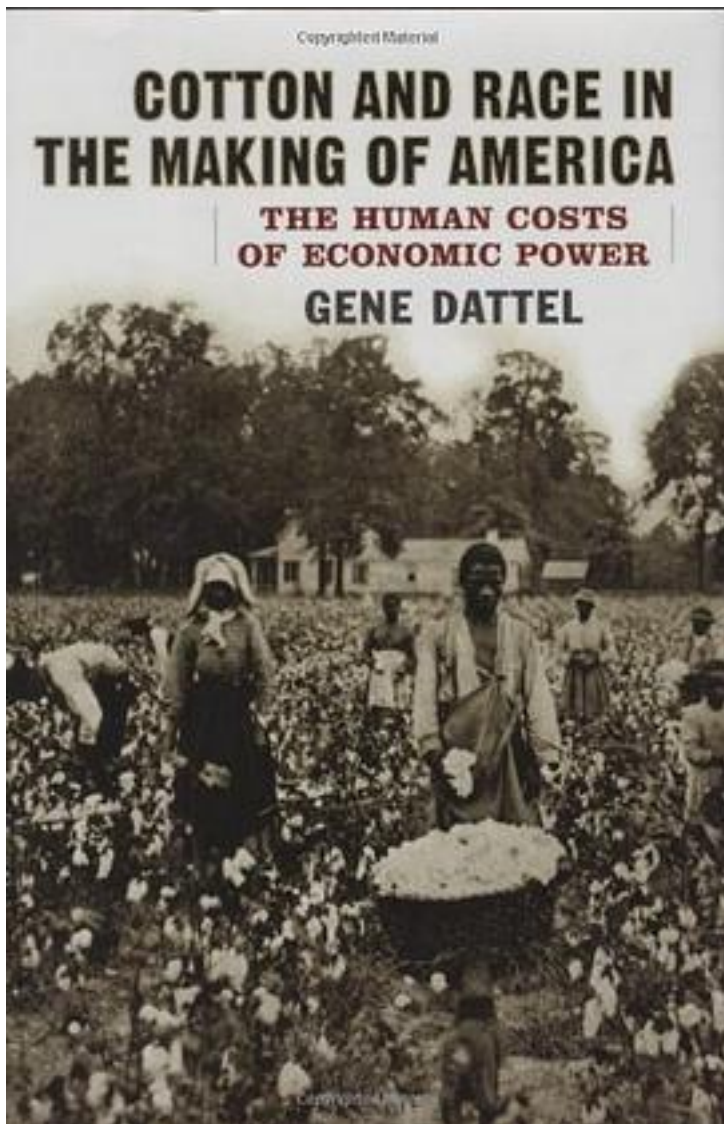

Since the earliest days of colonial America, the relationship between cotton and the African-American experience has been central to the history of the republic.
