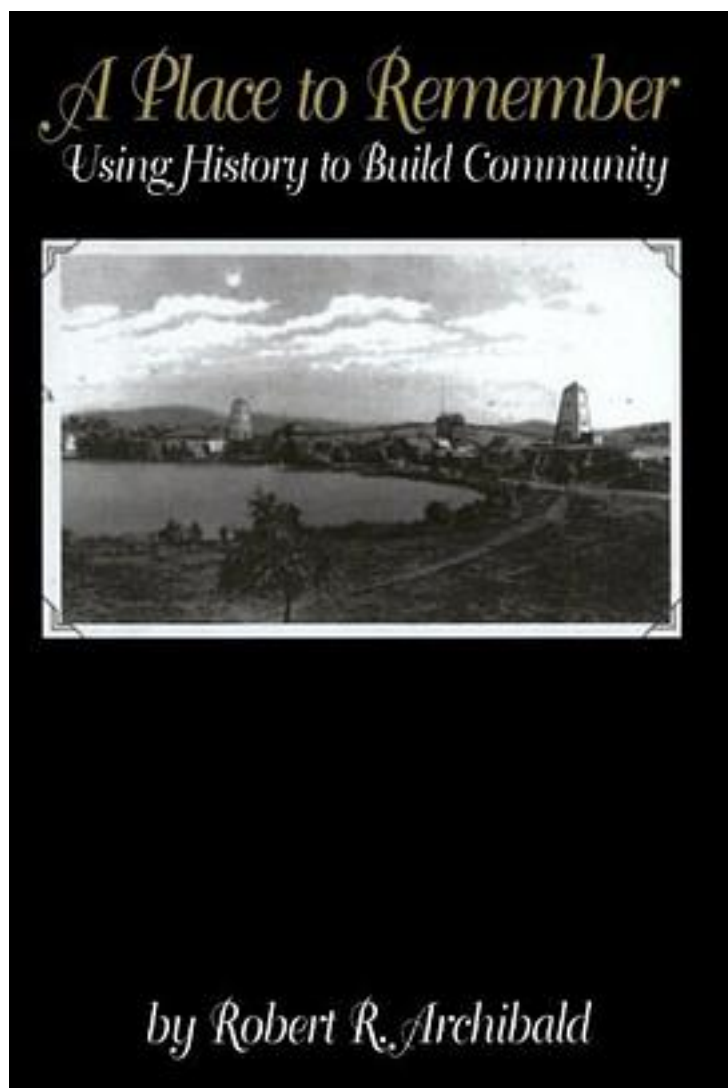


A Place to Remember
