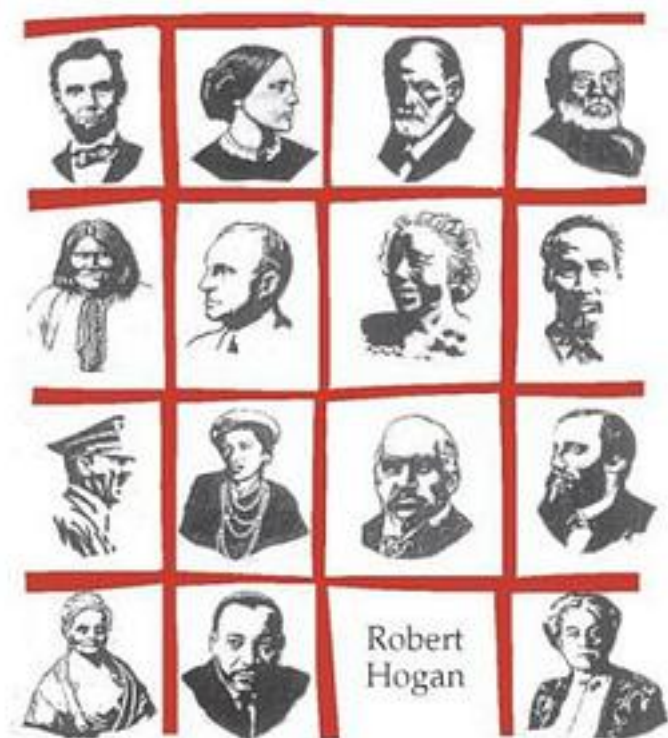


Personality and the Fate of Organizations
