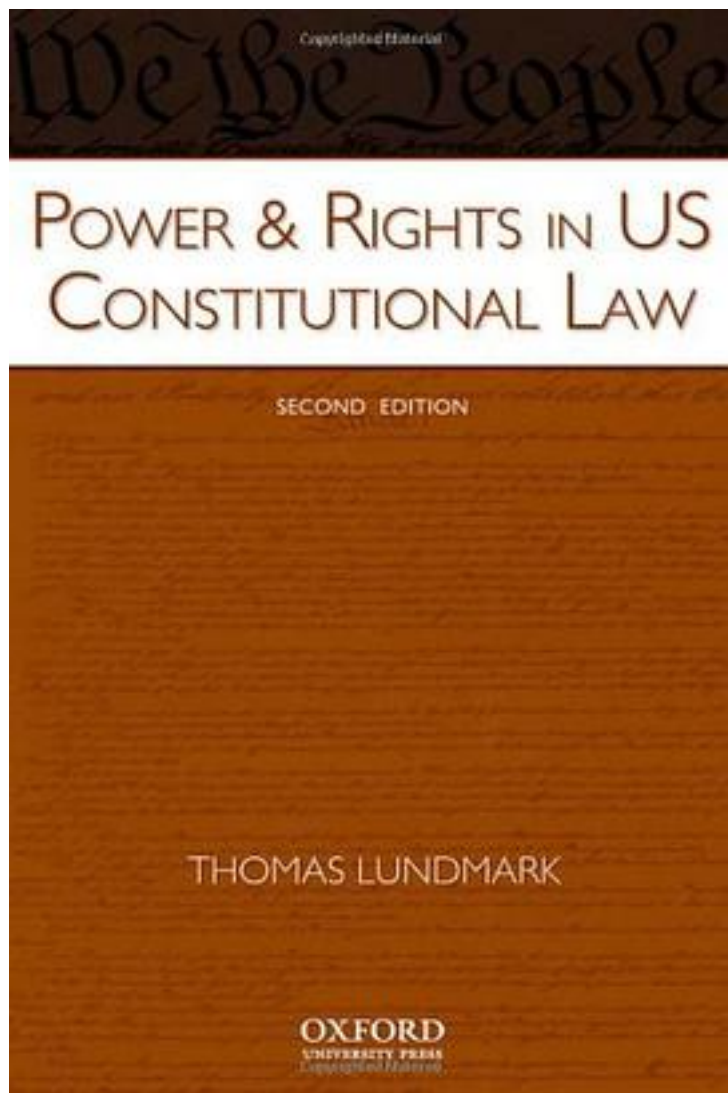


Power and Rights in US Constitutional Law
