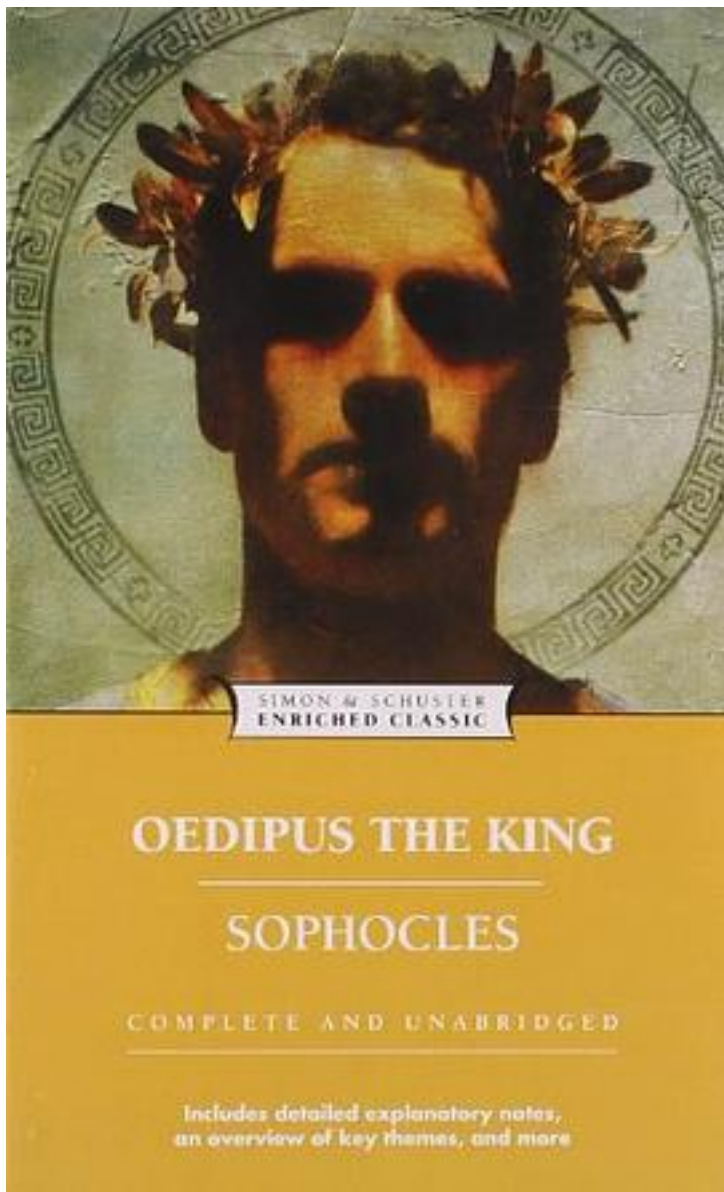


Oedipus the King
