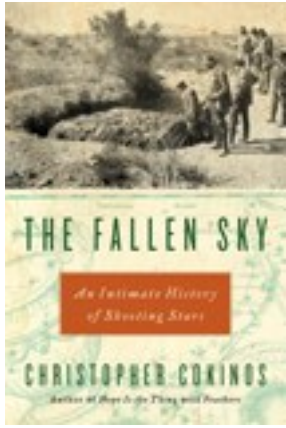

This sounds like story line to one or more modern films. However this book was first published in 1954. Some compared his style to H.G.Wells and Ray Bradbury and now this gem of a book is widely available again. The author, Peter Crowcroft, was a commando in the Second World War and maintained this was his protest against the atom bomb. He went on to Hollywood to write scripts, books of films and to act in "On a Clear Day" with Barbra Steisand.
