

The theory of Grobner bases, invented by Bruno Buchberger, is a general method by which many fundamental problems in various branches of mathematics and engineering can be solved by structurally simple algorithms. It is in two parts, the first consisting of tutorial lectures, beginning with a general introduction. In the second part are seventeen original research papers on Grobner bases. An appendix contains the English translations of the original German papers of Bruno Buchberger in which Grobner bases were introduced.
