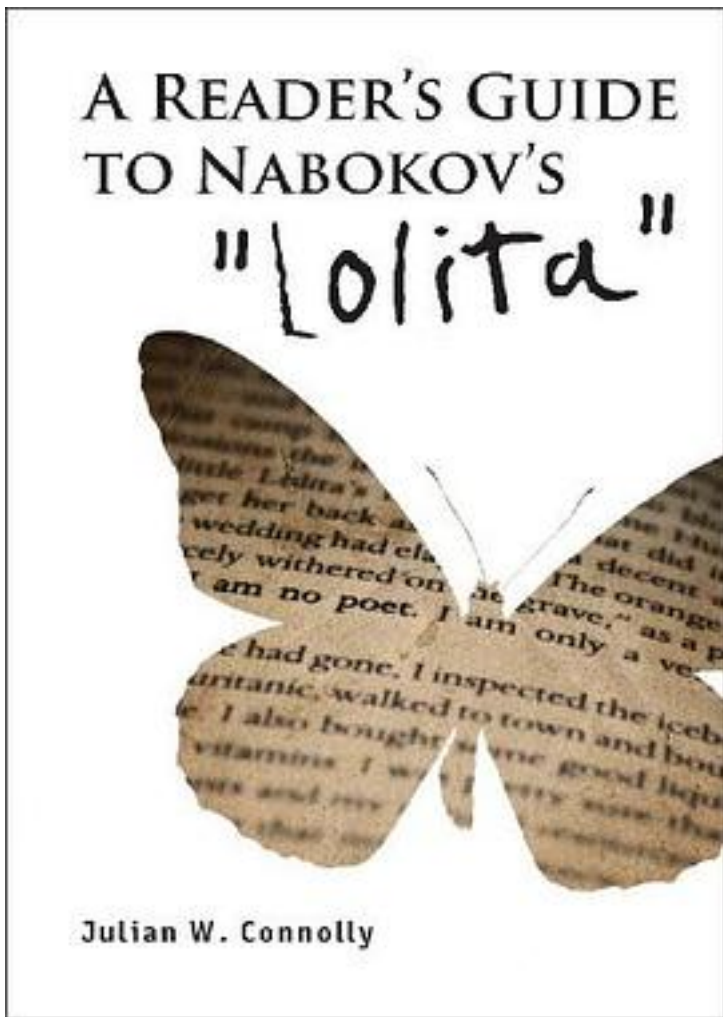

Vladimir Nabokov's "Lolita" is one of the most fascinating and controversial novels of

the twentieth century. This book seeks to guide readers through the intricacies of Nabokov's work and to help them achieve a better understanding of his rich artistic design. The guide should prove illuminating both for first-time readers of "Lolita" and for experienced re-readers of Nabokov's text. JULIAN W. CONNOLLY (Ph.D. Harvard, 1977) is Professor of Slavic Languages and Literatures at the University of Virginia. He is the author of "Nabokov's Early Fiction: Patterns of Self and Other" (1992) and editor of "Nabokov and His Fiction: New Perspectives" (1999) and The Cambridge Companion to Nabokov (2005). He has published over sixty articles on Russian literature.
